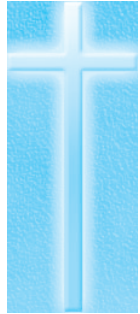

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples are to make arrangements with the parish priest at least six months prior to the intended date. Must also be registered in the parish for at least six months prior to the wedding and attend a marriage pre-session. Please call the parish office for more information or to make an appointment.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

If you wish to have your child baptized, please call Deacon Tim Leininger for details. Baptism is held on the last weekend of the month (at 5:00 PM Mass on Saturday or the 10:00 AM Mass on Sunday) unless you make special arrangements. We encourage you to schedule the Baptism even before the baby is born. You must be registered in the parish for at least three months prior to the Baptism. Baptism classes are the first Sunday of each month at 9:00 AM in the Rectory Lower Level. Adults interested in joining the Catholic Faith should call Deacon Tom Schulte.

Pastor's Corner

There was an interesting article about asking forgiveness in the USA Today last week. Research shows that women apologize more often than men do, NOT because they commit more wrongdoing. They just think they do! Men seem to have a "higher threshold" for unacceptable behavior, or simply they just don't see "wrong" (or sin) the same way women do. Men were less likely to be offended than women and were less likely to think they committed wrongdoing. Yet, in men's defense, men didn't avoid apologizing or refuse to admit they were wrong. They were just as likely to apologize if they believed they were truly in the wrong. Regardless of gender differences, the gospel calls us all to sharpen our consciences and recognize sin for what it is, asking God and one another for forgiveness, so all of our hearts may heal.

FROM THE LITURGIST'S DESK

The Hail Mary is formally
called the "Angelic Salutation"
since it is based on a passage
from the Gospel of Luke which
contains the first line of the
prayer. By the beginning of the
12th century, the first part of the prayer was in common
use in the liturgy of the West. The second part of the
prayer, beginning "Holy Mary" was added about the
15th century.

The "Mysteries" of the Rosary evolved down through
the centuries along with the Rosary itself. Those praying
the devotion were able to recall important events in the
lives of Jesus and Mary and , as time allowed, to medi-
tate on them with the use of quotations from scripture.

On Oct. 16, 2002, Pope John Paul II in his apostolic
letter "*Rosarium Virginis Marie*" "The Rosary of the
Blessed Virgin Mary" added five new mysteries to the
traditional Dominican rosary. The "Luminous Mysteries"
or Mysteries of Light", complete the Rosary by focusing
on the public mystery of Jesus in the time between his
baptism and passion. The complete rosary of John Paul
II then consists of twenty decades, divided into four part,
with each one consisting of five decades. So, you would
begin with the Joyful Mysteries, then the Luminous Mys-
teries, the Sorrowful Mysteries and conclude with the
Glorious Mysteries. Don't have time for this? Next week
"A Little Key to Heaven" and other devotions.
