This is the third weekend of the sessions on the Revised Roman Missal. Deacon Aulner will speak at all Masses on the Introductory rites. The Introductory Rites are the first of the four parts of the Liturgy: 1) Introductory Rites, 2) Liturgy of the Word, 3) Liturgy of the Eucharist, 4) Concluding Rites. In each part, many of the words will not change, but some will. The Introductory Rites include everything that happens from the moment we stand until we sit for the first time to hear the First Reading. We have already made some of the changes, chanting the greeting. We will also be moving in front of the altar for the opening rites in order to be seen/heard more clearly. Please read the pamphlet enclosed in the bulletin on the Introductory Rites. There will be a pamphlet for each week. For that reason there will be no other inserts so we can focus on this information. Have a good week,
