In the month of February at Holy Ghost begins the season of Lent and our Fish Fry's. At church, you would notice that the second collection is for the sidewalk and parking lot resurfacing project. Well, the sidewalks are done, so we will remove that from the announcements and just gear towards the parking lot. In the spring, we will be having an asphalt company patch all of the bad areas of the lot and lower driveway next to the school. The lot will then be crack sealed, then spray coated, and restriped. The goal target amount to complete this is about \$20,000.
